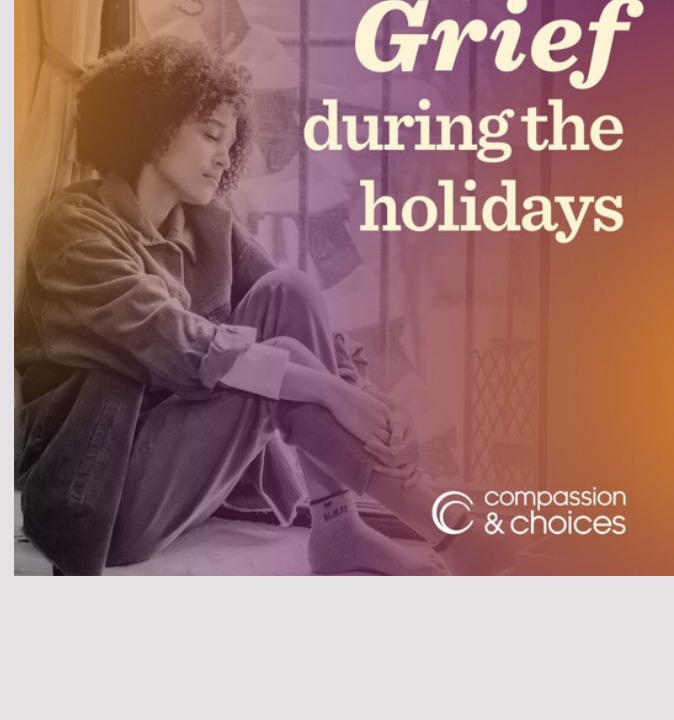




SEASON OF SUPPORT: Navigating Holiday Grief

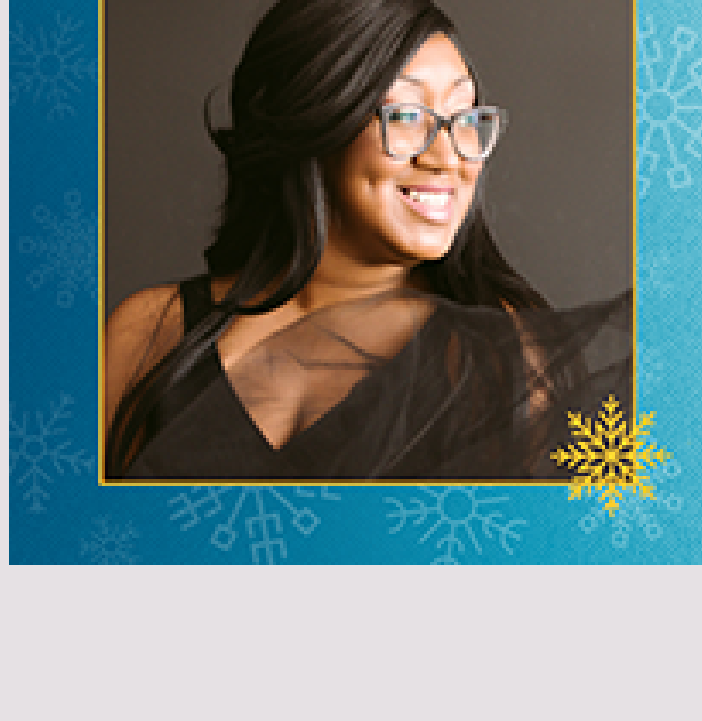
LIVE WEBINAR: Exciting Learning Opportunity

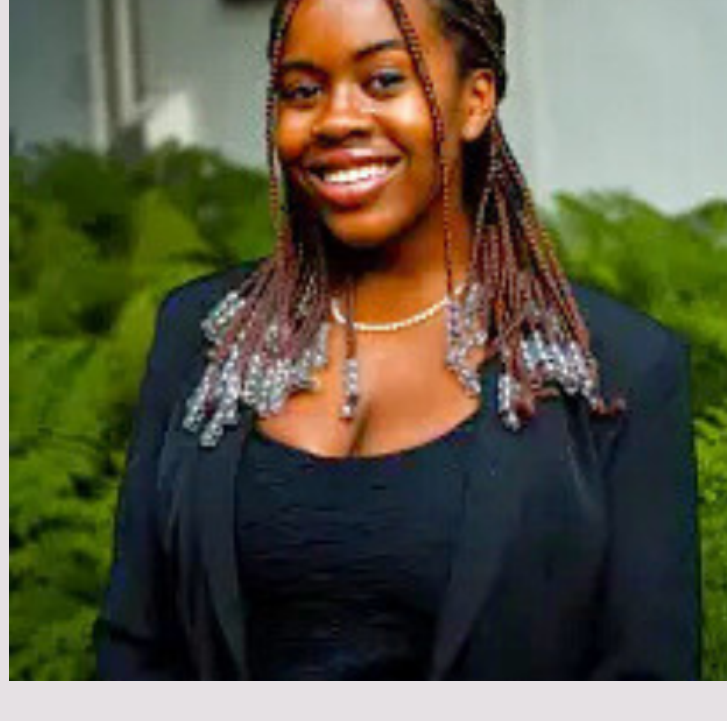
INSPIRED AND JOYFUL: 3 Takeaways from End Well 2024
