It's Nearly Time to Share Your Abundance!



EFN's network of over 75 partner food pantries, meal sites, and shelters is currently serving more than 200,000 visits each month, which is higher than any other time in our history. The funds raised at Abundance will help EFN distribute more than 14 million pounds of food this year so that no person goes hungry.



Catch-Up on EFN's Construction

The construction crew has been hard at work since the beginning of September, digging and laying the foundation for our new warehouse. Sewer and electrical lines have been set in place, and we are waiting for the concrete to set. We expect the building panels to arrive mid-October.

You must be wondering what the new building will look like. We are projecting the new warehouse to take up 21,500 square feet. If you've been to our Lakewood campus before, imagine the size of our current warehouse but taller. While construction will increase traffic and noise for the next few months, this project will help EFN meet the increasing need for a consistent food supply within Pierce County.

It's exciting to see the new warehouse slowly come to life!

zucchini. We've been blown away at


the production of each crop and can't

Volunteer Highlight


Thank You TwinStar Credit Union!
